

Please read through our handbook and note all programs taking place this year.

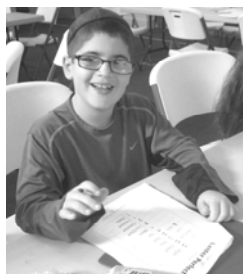

The Goals of Chabad Hebrew School are:

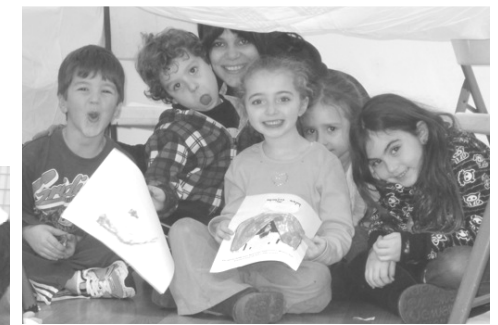
- To provide an education that instills pride, a sense of history and a genuine and meaningful understanding of what Judaism is about.

HOURS:

LOCATION:

Classes are held at Chabad. There is street parking along Broadway.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

In the event of inclement weather on a school day, parents will be notified by telephone if classes are canceled. You can also check www.chabadrt.org for any changes in schedule.

ATTENDANCE:

Please let the school know ahead of time if your child will be absent. We want to establish good habits in relation to school from the start, so we request that you bring your child to school on time. School begins punctually at 10:00 A.M. Latecomers miss important parts of the lesson and often have difficulty adjusting to the rhythm of the class.



GENERAL INFORMATION

DISMISSAL:

Class ends at 12:15 PM. Please come inside to pick up your child. We ask you as a courtesy to pick up your child on time, as the faculty cannot leave until every child has left the building.

SNACKS AND SUPPLIES:

The school will be providing all necessary supplies and snacks. Please make sure to send in the \$36.00 supply, book and snack fee with your child's registration.

SCHOOL RECORDS AND FIRST AID:

Minor injuries will be taken care of by the school staff. Should anything serious occur, G-d forbid, the parents or emergency contact will be notified and the child will be taken to the nearest hospital if necessary.

Parents are asked to please notify the school director of any change of address, telephone numbers, as well as any changes regarding allergies or medical conditions. This enables us to keep our records current and allows us to communicate with the home when necessary.
